2. This is a handicap event: 90% of 210
3. Averages will be determined by:
 - A. Highest current 2019-2020 Cedar Bowl League average of 21 games or more as of Feb 8th, 2020
 - B. Highest current 2019-2020 league average of 21 games or more as of Feb 8th, 2020
 - C. Cedar Bowl averages verified by Tournament Director. All other bowlers must bring average sheets verifying his/hers average of 21 games or more
4. Participants who report incorrect averages will be disqualified. It is the bowlers responsibility to verify her/his own average. (Tournament management has the authority to assign an average higher than the minimum average prior to participation (rule #319b) 319d & e will be waived.
5. **FORMAT:** Bowl 4 Games - throw out teams lowest game. Winners will be determined on each team's 3 game total.
6. Multiple entries are allowed with a different partner, but payouts will be paid with combination of both squads.
7. Squad Times as follows:
 - A. Sat. Feb 15th @ 11:00 am
 - B. Sat. Feb 15th @ 2:00 pm
8. Practice Time: 5 minutes
9. No entry fee will be returned. Prize money will be distributed 1 in 3 entries
